Materials

- 400g DK weight yarn in main colour
- 100g DK weight yarn in contrast colour
- 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle

Instructions

Main Colour

1. Ch 100
2. Sc into the second ch from the hook and each ch across (99 sc)
3. Ch 1, turn
4. Sc into each sc across (99 sc)
5. Repeat rows 3-4 until the piece measures approximately 35cm long

Contrast Colour

1. Ch 10
2. Sc into the second ch from the hook and each ch across (9 sc)
3. Ch 1, turn
4. Sc into each sc across (9 sc)
5. Repeat rows 3-4 until the piece measures approximately 10cm long

Assembly

1. Lay the main colour piece flat and fold it in half lengthwise, matching the edges
2. Sew the side seams together
3. Fold the bottom edge of the top up by 5cm and sew it down
4. Fold the top edge of the top over by 2.5cm and sew it down

5. Attach the contrast colour piece to the centre of the hood by sewing along the edges
6. Fold the hood in half and sew the sides together

Finishing

1. Weave in any loose ends
2. Block the top to shape it

Tips

- If you are a beginner, I recommend using a light-coloured yarn so that you can easily see your stitches
- Be sure to check your gauge before you start crocheting to ensure that your top will fit correctly
- If you need help with any of the stitches, there are many tutorials available online
- Have fun crocheting your hooded top!

Pattern

Ch = Chain

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

hdc = Half double crochet

dc = Double crochet

tr = Treble crochet

dtr = Double treble crochet

ttr = Triple treble crochet

fpdc = Front post double crochet

bpdc = Back post double crochet

Gauge: 10 sc x 10 rows = 10cm x 10cm

Size: 7 years

Materials: 400g DK weight yarn in main colour, 100g DK weight yarn in contrast colour, 4mm crochet hook, scissors, darning needle

Abbreviations: Ch = Chain, Sc = Single crochet, Sl st = Slip stitch, hdc = Half double crochet, dc = Double crochet, tr = Treble crochet, dtr = Double treble crochet, ttr = Triple treble crochet, fpdc = Front post double crochet, bpdc = Back post double crochet

Instructions:

1. **Main Colour:** Ch 100. Sc into the second ch from the hook and each ch across (99 sc). Ch 1, turn.
2. Sc into each sc across (99 sc). Ch 1, turn.
3. Repeat rows 3-4 until the piece measures approximately 35cm long.

4. **Contrast Colour:** Ch 10. Sc into the second ch from the hook and each ch across (9 sc). Ch 1, turn.
5. Sc into each sc across (9 sc). Ch 1, turn.
6. Repeat rows 3-4 until the piece measures approximately 10cm long.
7. **Assembly:** Lay the main colour piece flat and fold it in half lengthwise, matching the edges. Sew the side seams together.
8. Fold the bottom edge of the top up by 5cm and sew it down.
9. Fold the top edge of the top over by 2.5cm and sew it down.
10. Attach the contrast colour piece to the centre of the hood by sewing along the edges.
11. Fold the hood in half and sew the sides together.
12. **Finishing:** Weave in any loose ends. Block the top to shape it.



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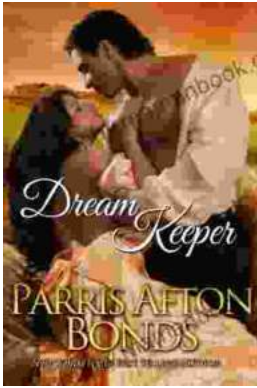
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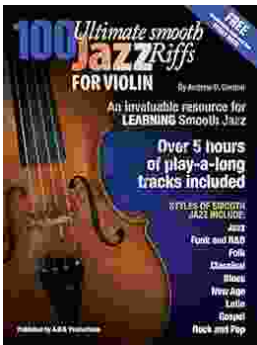
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
