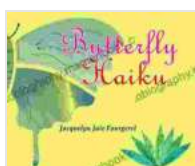

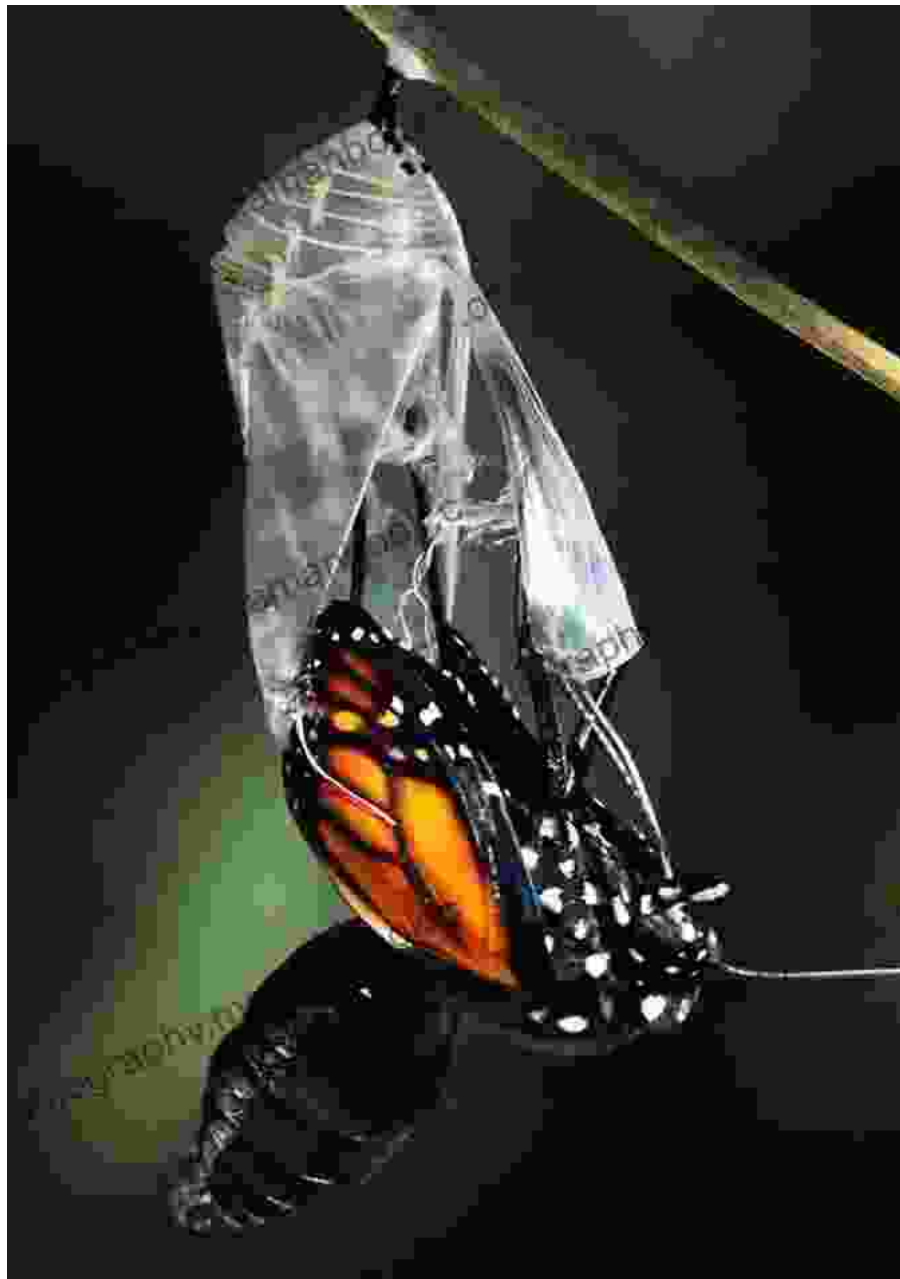
Soft wings now still,

In the following haiku, Fourgerel captures the pure joy of watching a butterfly flitting through a meadow:

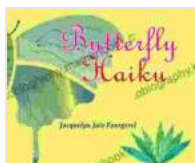


Dancing through flowers,

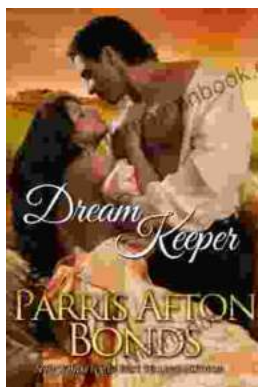
