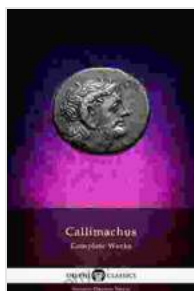


Delphi Complete Works of Callimachus: Illustrated Delphi Ancient Classics (Volume 84)

Callimachus was a Greek poet and scholar of the Hellenistic period, who lived from c. 310 to c. 240 BC. He was the chief librarian of the Library of Alexandria and a prolific writer of poetry in a variety of genres, including hymns, epigrams, and epyllia (short epic poems). His most famous work is the *Aetia*, a collection of aetiological poems that explain the origins of various customs and traditions.

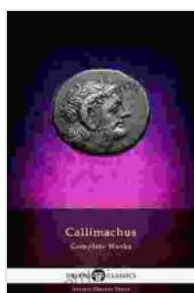

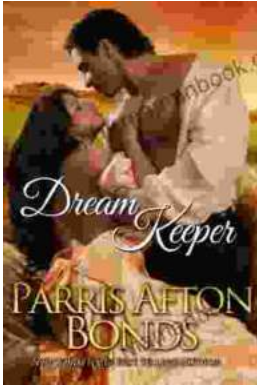

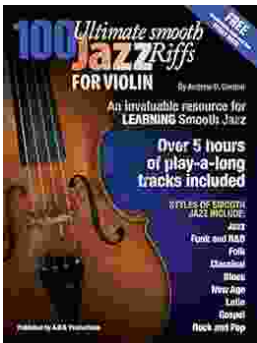
