### Method 1: Factory Reset Through Settings Menu

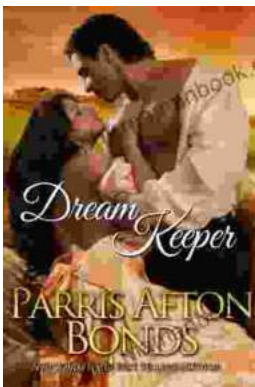

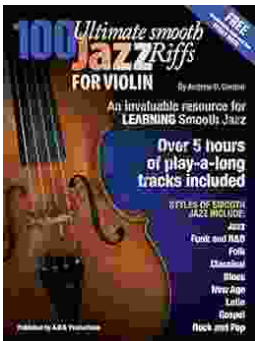
